

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon our diocese will take up The Catholic Relief Services Collection. Your support of this collection serves Jesus in the guise of those who are poor and vulnerable in the most marginalized communities in our world.

The Church is called to bring the Gospel to all people and accompany them in their lives of faith, regardless of their state in life, cultural heritage, or occupation. For people who travel most of the time for work—such as seafarers, truckers, airline workers, and itinerant entertainers and show workers—access to the sacraments, fellowship, and accompaniment are essential for strengthening their faith. This is especially true for circus and traveling show workers and their families.

For circus and traveling show performers and workers, life is communal and familial. People traveling together, often in families, have pastoral needs that require special attention, such as religious education and celebration of the Mass that are often inaccessible in local parishes due to time constraints associated with scheduled shows. Approximately 40% of circus and itinerant entertainers in the United States are Catholic, with performers hailing from countries around the world.

The circus and traveling shows ministry, an initiative of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Subcommittee on Pastoral Care of Migrants, Refugees, and Travelers (PCMRT), works to raise awareness and address the pastoral needs of performers. Among those doing this valuable ministry is Deacon Gary Nosacek, a circus and traveling show minister of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, who performs this ministry of presence and prayer with joy. With support from The Catholic Relief Services Collection, PCMRT attends to the needs of these families that might otherwise be unmet.

El Padre Fernando Orejuela Osorio nació en 1964. Creció en Cali Colombia con su familia y siendo joven, circunstancias de la vida lo llevaron a envolverse con la cultura de la droga. A los 17 años, una repentina y profunda experiencia con nuestro Señor Jesucristo cambió su vida completamente y lo encaminó hacia un nuevo rumbo. Las oraciones de su madre lo llevaron hacia el Sacerdocio siendo estudiante de abogacía. Completó estudios de filosofía y teología, ciencias políticas y sociales y se ordenó en la Arquidiócesis de Villavicencio el 22 de Junio de 1997.

El Padre Fernando Orejuela es miembro de la Comunidad de la Inmaculada Concepción, tiene mucha experiencia como líder de grupos juveniles, es un conocido conferecista y predicador a nivel internacional, ha llevado a cabo muchos retiros de parejas, peregrinaciones y encuentros de formación Cristiana. Es productor y conductor de programas de televisión desde el año 2000 en adelante, ha servido en varias diócesis en los Estados Unidos como conferencista, actualmente es párroco en la San Bonifacio en la Arquidiócesis de Miami, Florida y orienta y forma a los Fieles Laicos de la Asociacion Hijos de la Madre de Dios.

Fr. Enzo Del Brocco, is a Passionist missionary. He was born in Pittsburgh (PA) in 1969. In 1980 his family moved to Italy. He studied for Philosophy and Theology at the Pontificio Ateneo Antonianum in Rome and was ordained a Priest in 1996. He has a Master degree in Moral Theology (1999), in Human Resources (2010), a certification in Catholic Bioethics (2018) and is currently a Healthcare PhD candidate at Duquesne University. He has held various positions within the Passionist order serving for 8 years as Secretary to the Superior General (2000-2007), for two terms as Provincial Superior of the Passionists in Italy and in Brazil (2007-2013) and currently Vice Provincial of St. Paul of the Cross Province (Eastern USA, Canada, Puerto Rico, Jamaica and Haiti).

He traveled to several countries in Europe, Asia, Latina America and Africa serving the Congregation and he is fluent in six languages (english, italian, spanish, portoghese, french and creole). He is a well known preacher and has given several retreats and workshops in in English, italian, spanish and portughese. During his time as Provincial Superior in italy he worked with the Community of S. Egidio in one of the peripheries of Naples with the disabled and marginalized.

In January 2014 he joined Fr. Rick Frechette, founder of the St. Luke Foundation, in Haiti and worked with the marginalized in the slums of Cite Soleil, serving as chaplain of the st Luke hospital and doing pastoral outreach and towards the remote areas of the country. He has been particularly involved in the hurricane relief in the Province of Jeremie (Dame Marie and Abricot), where the Hurricane Matthew has caused major damages in 2016 and was also involved in the recent 2021 earthquake relief in Haiti.



Read

Today we honor St. Joseph, spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is interesting to note that St. Joseph's fatherhood and specific role in the plan of salvation would not have been possible apart from his marriage to Mary.

Reflect

St. John Paul II referred to St. Joseph as "the guardian and cooperator in the providential mystery of God (no 14)." He explained that, together with Mary, Joseph was the first guardian of Christ: "St. Joseph was called by God to serve the person and mission of Jesus directly through the exercise of his fatherhood (no 8)."

Pray

We pray for all fathers, that through the example of St. Joseph, they may fully embrace their vocation and accept the privilege and responsibility of caring for their children as St. Joseph cared for Jesus.

Act

St. Joseph, the model of humility and trust, and one of the Church's greatest saint, is often discussed as being silent, as he speaks no words in the Bible. But, his silence speaks volumes. In it, the Church recognizes his faithfulness, his love, and his acceptance of the Holy Will of god. Take a moment today to mediate on this gift of silence.


