



SOMETHING NEW IN CHRIST

Jesus knew that the scribes and Pharisees were trying to trap him. They put him in what seemed to be a no-win situation. Let the woman who was caught in adultery go, and he would have been accused of ignoring the law. Let her be stoned, and he would fail to show mercy toward her, contradicting his life's message. Jesus' response teaches three crucial lessons: none of us is free of sin; we are not the ultimate judges of others; Jesus is the mercy of God, in whom we can always trust. In Christ, God does something new. When we give our hearts to Christ, we have the hope of new life, a life in which mercy reigns.

Jesús sabía que los escribas y los fariseos estaban tratando de atraparlo. Ellos lo pusieron en lo que parecía ser un callejón sin salida. En Cristo, Dios hace algo nuevo. Cuando damos nuestros corazones a Cristo, tenemos la esperanza de una nueva vida, una vida en la que la misericordia reina.



“The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason, the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation.... Participation in the communal celebration of the Sunday Eucharist is a testimony of belonging and being faithful to Christ and to his Church. (Cf CCC 2181, 2182)

Effective Palm Sunday, April 10, 2022, the obligation to participate in the Eucharist in person on Sundays and other holy days of obligation is restored. Unless excused for a serious reason (illness, care of infants or elderly, etc.) those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin.

The Palm Sunday date was chosen to give pastors adequate time to prepare their parishioners and perhaps readjust Mass schedules, etc. As already published, mask requirements as well as requirements for social distancing have been lifted.

In March 2020, because of the extraordinary circumstances surrounding the Corona virus pandemic, the obligation of the faithful to participate in the Mass on Sundays and other holy days of obligation was suspended – although all were encouraged to participate in Mass via livestreamed or by “keeping holy the Lord’s Day” through prayer and reflection on the Scriptures personally or with their families.

Fr. Enzo Del Brocco, is a Passionist missionary. He was born in Pittsburgh (PA) in 1969. In 1980 his family moved to Italy. He studied for Philosophy and Theology at the Pontificio Ateneo Antonianum in Rome and was ordained a Priest in 1996. He has a Master degree in Moral Theology (1999), in Human Resources (2010), a certification in Catholic Bioethics (2018) and is currently a Healthcare PhD candidate at Duquesne University. He has held various positions within the Passionist order serving for 8 years as Secretary to the Superior General (2000-2007), for two terms as Provincial Superior of the Passionists in Italy and in Brazil (2007-2013) and currently Vice Provincial of St. Paul of the Cross Province (Eastern USA, Canada, Puerto Rico, Jamaica and Haiti).

He traveled to several countries in Europe, Asia, Latina America and Africa serving the Congregation and he is fluent in six languages (english, italian, spanish, portuguese, french and creole). He is a well known preacher and has given several retreats and workshops in in English, italian, spanish and portuguese. During his time as Provincial Superior in italy he worked with the Community of S. Egidio in one of the peripheries of Naples with the disabled and marginalized.

In January 2014 he joined Fr. Rick Frechette, founder of the St. Luke Foundation, in Haiti and worked with the marginalized in the slums of Cite Soleil, serving as chaplain of the st Luke hospital and doing pastoral outreach and towards the remote areas of the country. He has been particularly involved in the hurricane relief in the Province of Jeremie (Dame Marie and Abricot), where the Hurricane Matthew has caused major damages in 2016 and was also involved in the recent 2021 earthquake relief in Haiti.
