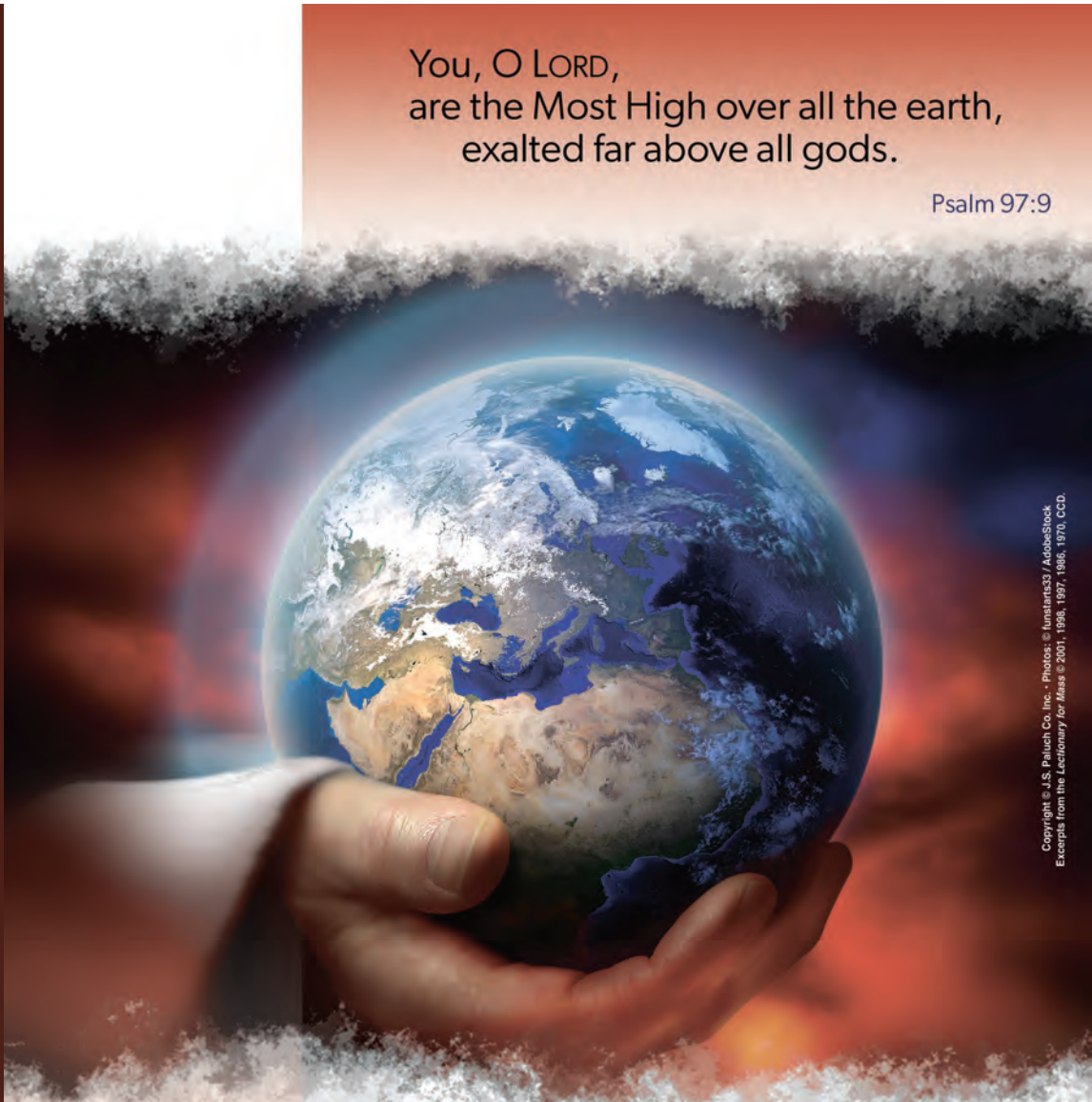

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Since the Fall of the Berlin Wall and the end of communism in Eastern Europe the Church in the United States has supported the Church in the countries of the former Soviet Bloc through our annual collection for the Church in Eastern Europe.

This collection supports many of the charitable activities of the Church in these countries in addition to helping rebuild Church infrastructure, including parish churches, pastoral centers, seminaries, as well as supporting the resurgence of religious life in these nations.

For example, in Belarus, through the Tabita program, operated by Caritas Belarus, the collection supports and assists people with disabilities with their physical, social, psychological, and spiritual needs.

However, the grave situation in Ukraine has created a world of pain and need that the Church is seeking to address both in Ukraine and in the countries, such as Poland, where many Ukrainian nationals have sought refuge.

Your support of the Collection for the Church in Eastern Europe will go a long way in helping your fellow Catholics to respond to the urgent pastoral and social needs of the Ukrainian people.

Please be generous to the collection. Thank you for your help to restore the Church and build a future of hope in Central and Eastern Europe.

NEVER A DULL MOMENT

Today's readings take us through a wide range of powerful feelings; they seem to promise that the life of a believer will never be dull. In the Acts of the Apostles, we see Stephen become the first martyr among Jesus' followers. His attackers harbor such rage toward him and his words about Jesus that they cover their ears as they run toward him. Before he dies, Stephen asks the Lord to forgive his murderers. The reading from Revelation uses the word come six times, assuring us that the Lord hears the prayers of witnesses like Stephen. God, who is Alpha and Omega, invites faithful followers to enter into the eternal city. As John's Gospel assures us, we glimpse heaven even now, in daily life, when we tend to our loving relationship with God. Rage, forgiveness, violence, paradise, intimacy—today's readings help us understand the demands and ecstasies of discipleship.

Sus atacantes guardan tanta rabia hacia él y sus palabras acerca de Jesús que se tapan los oídos mientras corren hacia él. Antes de morir, Esteban pide al Señor que perdone a sus asesinos. En el texto de la lectura del Apocalipsis la palabra venir está seis veces, asegurándose que el Señor escucha las oraciones de los testigos como Esteban. Dios, que es el Alfa y la Omega, invita a los seguidores fieles a entrar a la ciudad eterna. Como nos asegura el Evangelio de Juan, vislumbramos el cielo incluso ahora, en la vida cotidiana, cuando atendemos a nuestra relación de amor con Dios. La rabia, el perdón, la violencia, el paraíso, la intimidad: las lecturas de hoy nos ayudan a comprender las exigencias y los éxtasis del discipulado.

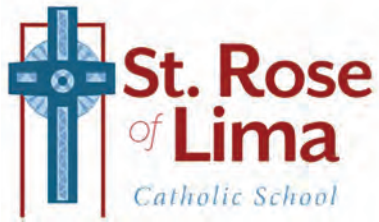

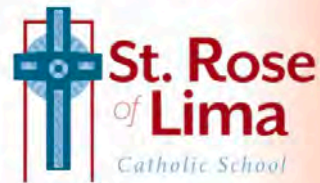
