

Don't delude yourselves, Jesus says through the parable of the rich man and Lazarus. We really are supposed to care for others. As disciples, we must "pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness." Jesus calls us to see and respond to the least among us, because, as God's children, we are all part of one another.


#### **Ushers and Greeters**


### SAVE THE DATE
