





St. Rose of Lima School opened on Sept. 12, 1951

with 12 classrooms and a cafeteria. It was staffed by the Adrian Dominican Sisters.

Over 400 students were enrolled in grades 1 through 6.

On Oct. 1, 1951, 50 five year old children began attending Kindergarten.




