Things you need to know before class begins:

- Catechist will be sending you an email invitation for each scheduled class. Please make sure that your child is ready for their lesson by at least a few minutes before class time begins. Absences (not more than 3 absences allowed) and tardiness will be recorded.
- On the first day of class, please be present to meet the Catechist and get information about the whole year.
- Student Book distribution will take place on Saturday morning, Sept. 19 starting at 9 am to 10 am. If you cannot make it, please email me so that you can come by the parish office during regular office hours to pick up your child/ren book(s) at your earliest convenience.
- If you need to drop off any Baptismal certificate, you may use the book distribution day to do so or just come the office to drop off.

Home/ class environment:

- Make sure that they are in an environment where they won't be distracted.
- Make sure they have their book or anything else they will need like a pen or pencil ready.
- They should be dressed appropriately as if they were going to class.

Classes will meet by grades and schedules are as follow:

- Sunday classes 10:30 am to 11: 30 am K-6, Sacramental prep and RCIC students.
- Tuesday nights 7 pm to 8 pm for 7th and 8th grades.
