

IN THE DESERT

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God's presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God's ways behind. On this First Sunday of Lent, Jesus shows us what to do in these moments: stand firm and trust in God.

Algunas veces también nosotros pasamos tiempo en el desierto. Literalmente no es un desierto muchas de las veces, sino un desierto en el que parece difícil percibir la presencia de Dios, momentos en los que nos enfrentamos a la dificultad y somos tentados a dejar atrás los caminos de Dios. En este Primer Domingo de Cuaresma, lesús nos muestra qué hacer en esos momentos: mantenernos firmes y confiar en Dios.



Fr. Enzo Del Brocco, is a Passionist missionary. He was born in Pittsburgh (PA) in 1969. In 1980 his family moved to Italy. He studied for Philosophy and Theology at the Pontificio Ateneo Antonianum in Rome and was ordained a Priest in 1996. He has a Master degree in Moral Theology (1999), in Human Resources (2010), a certification in Catholic Bioethics (2018) and is currently a Healthcare PhD candidate at Duquesne University. He has held various positions within the Passionist order serving for 8 years as Secretary to the Superior General (2000-2007), for two terms as Provincial Superior of the Passionists in Italy and in Brazil (2007-2013) and currently Vice Provincial of St. Paul of the Cross Provinice (Eastern USA, Canada, Puerto Rico, Jamaica and Haiti).

He traveled to several countries in Europe, Asia, Latina America and Africa serving the Congregation and he is fluent in six languages (english, italian, spanish, portoghese, french and creole). He is a well known preacher and has given several retreats and workshops in in English, italian, spanish and portughese. During his time as Provincial Superior in italy he worked with the Community of S. Egidio in one of the peripheries of Naples with the disabled and marginalized.

In January 2014 he joined Fr. Rick Frechette, founder of the St. Luke Foundation, in Haiti and worked with the marginalized in the slums of Cite Soleil, serving as chaplain of the st Luke hospital and doing pastoral outreach and towards the remote areas of the country. He has been particularly involved in the hurricane relief in the Province of Jeremie (Dame Marie and Abricot), where the Hurricane Matthew has caused major damages in 2016 and was also involved in the recent 2021 earthquake relief in Haiti.



Revised Protocols for Mass and other liturgical services: Effective March 1, 2022

Given the low incidence of the corona virus in our community at this time, we are confident that we can ease our protocols.

Effective March 1, 2022, the use of masks is optional regardless of vaccination status and social distancing no longer needs to be enforced in churches.

- Offertory processions are permitted; and priests (and or deacons) may invite the people to share a sign of peace at the appropriate place in the Mass.
- However, those distributing Holy Communion (priests, deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are asked to continue to sanitize their hands and wear a mask during distribution (for the mutual protection of the communicant and the minister of Holy Communion).
- Priests concelebrating should receive the Precious Blood by intinction, and chalice will
 not be offered to the faithful for the time being.

Those who feel sick (or experience flu like symptoms) should stay home and continue to follow Mass by live-stream.

The dispensation from the obligation of participation in Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation remains in effect – again for the time being.

(These changes – regarding mask protocols and social distancing – do not apply to our Schools. The Office of Schools establishes for the schools their own Corona virus procedures and protocols)




