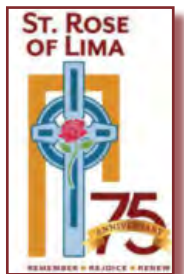

Archdiocese of Miami Safe Environment This is a five-part series for April Child Abuse Prevention Month



It is an opportunity to share the efforts made all year long to protect the most vulnerable among us. A significant part of this effort is the continuous work of Local Coordinator. They serve as a liaison between pastor/principal/director and the employees, parents, and volunteers at all ADOM entities. They communicate the commitment to child protection and the tangible steps to ensure it. This means fostering a sense of teamwork and a multifaceted playbook including background checks through fingerprinting every five years. Virtus training, which is an educational awareness and prevention program beginning with initial training and followed up with monthly bulletins thereafter. The last component is a signed Pledge to Promote Safe Environment, which is similar to a code of conduct. These requirements, in word and deed, illuminate the scope and nature of abuse and the necessity for changing hearts, minds, and behavior to prevent this crime at ADOM entities. www.miamiarch.org

Es una oportunidad para compartir los esfuerzos realizados durante todo el año a fin de proteger a los más vulnerables entre nosotros. Una parte importante de este esfuerzo es el trabajo continuo de los coordinadores locales, quienes sirven de enlace entre el párroco/director y los empleados, padres y voluntarios de todas las instituciones de la Arquidiócesis. Comunican el compromiso con la protección infantil y los pasos concretos para garantizarla. Esto significa mantener un sentido de trabajo en equipo y un manual abarcador que incluye la comprobación de antecedentes mediante la toma de huellas dactilares cada cinco años, y la capacitación en Virtus, un programa educativo de concienciación y prevención que comienza con la preparación inicial, y continúa con boletines mensuales. El último componente es la firma de la Promesa para Promover un Ambiente Seguro, similar a un código de conducta. Estos requisitos de palabra y obra revelan el alcance y la naturaleza del abuso, además de la necesidad de cambiar los corazones, las mentes y el comportamiento para prevenir este delito en las instituciones arquidiocesanas. www.miamiarch.org
