

St. Rose Journeys to See the Pope

On September 11, 1987, St. Rose parishioners boarded buses in the St. Rose parking lot to join 200,000 people at Tamiami Park where Pope John Paul II (Now St. John Paul II) was going to celebrate an outdoor Mass. It was part of the Pope's 2-day visit to Miami. The day had started off sunny and hot. However, by the time the Pope arrived and began his tour of the area in the "Popemobile," it began to sprinkle. Two thirds of the way through the Mass, violent lightening cracked across the sky and the rain came down in sheets. The Pope continued with his homily, but as the lightening and the rain intensified, the decision was made to stop the Mass. The Pope finished the Mass in a trailer behind the altar. Even though everyone went home wet and disappointed, all agreed that it was a spiritually uplifting experience. They were grateful to be in the presence of such a holy man. It was a once in a lifetime experience. They were not only in the presence of a Pope but also in the presence of a Saint.
