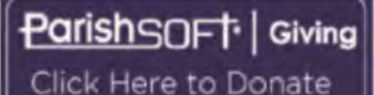

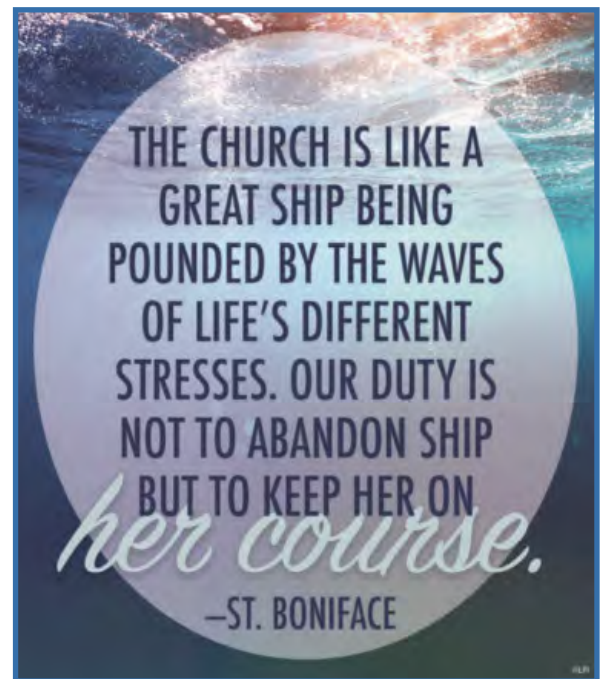

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Once I asked a fallen-away Catholic friend of mine what he remembered about the parish priest from his youth. He said, “He was a gentle, nice guy. Kind of vanilla. Kept to himself.” It struck me that he, perhaps like many, perceive Catholic priests as the following: lonely, harmless, and self-sufficient. As a challenge both to this perception (accurate or not) and to us priests who perhaps feel a pull in that uninspiring direction, stands the mighty image of what we see in the Gospel this Sunday.

Jesus sent out his apostles, “**two-by-two, with power over demons, and without money belts.**” **Two-by-two:** they enjoyed deep fellowship and brotherhood. **Power over demons:** they were anything but harmless. These men wielded enormous power against evil. **Without money belts:** they were not self-sufficient. They needed others to help them. Not lonely, but in community. Not harmless but armed with massive spiritual energy. Not self-sufficient, but poor and in need of help.

This is a challenge to me, and perhaps to all of us, living in a rich, secularized, and individualized culture. Do I embrace my priestly ministry in deep fellowship with other priests? Do I speak and act boldly to drive out evil where it is found? Do I live poorly and simply, trusting in the help of those around me even for basic needs? The fruitfulness of priestly ministry largely depends on these three traits. Let's pray for all priests — and, by extension, all of us Christians — to live more like Jesus' communal, poor, and powerful apostles.

Con frecuencia escuchamos de los sacerdotes de nuestras parroquias o de nuestros padres e inclusive de amigos la siguiente frase: “*Confiar siempre en Dios*”. Claro que confiamos, cuando nos va bien, cuando tenemos bonanza en nuestra vida. Pero, si llega una enfermedad, si nos quedamos sin trabajo, si muere un ser querido. ¿Confiamos? La respuesta va de acuerdo a nuestra relación personal con Dios, a nuestra fe y confianza que hemos desarrollado en nuestra vida hacia él. Ser fiel y confiar en Dios es contemplar su rostro en cada circunstancia, en cada trago amargo que pasamos y también en las cosas gratas de la familia y comunidad. En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos cómo Jesús envía a sus apóstoles a misión para continuar su obra misionera. Y se relaciona estrechamente con la vocación del profeta Amós: “*Yo no soy profeta ni uno de los hermanos profetas; soy cuidador de rebaños y trato los sicómoros*” (Amós 7:14). Todo trata de la confianza plena en Dios para cumplir con lo que nos toca hacer. Siempre se muestra la misericordia de Dios al cumplir su voluntad. El Señor muestra su bondad y su amor en todo momento; pero, hay que estar alerta a su voz y a su pedido y además no llevar nada para el camino. Ahora nos diría, ni siquiera el celular ni la computadora. Solo el corazón bien dispuesto para trabajar en su viña. ¿Podremos? La tecnología debe estar a nuestro servicio, no nosotros al servicio de ella. Imitemos a los servidores públicos y parroquiales que cumplen su misión siempre confiando en Dios.

What We Carry from Town to Town

In my experience, there are two kinds of people: the folks who kick off their shoes the second they walk through the door, and the ones who don't.

People can feel strongly about this on both sides. The main thrust of the Shoes-Off Brigade seems to be this: we track a lot of weird stuff on the soles of our feet. Little reminders of all the places we've been — whether it's a private home or a public bathroom — cling to our shoes long after we leave. This same theory applies to our spiritual lives. As human beings and as disciples, we visit a lot of figurative towns and pick up a lot of figurative dust. Sinfulness. Shame. Defeat. Anger. Fear. Doubt. No matter how hard we try to keep free of it, these things have a way of attaching themselves to us, sometimes without us even noticing. We need to take a good look at what unhelpful and unconstructive baggage from our past we're tracking into our present and future encounters. What is the “town” God is asking you to visit today in His name? Is it a tough conversation with a friend, a brief witness to a stranger in the checkout line, a call to be present to someone in your family? Before you go, remember, shake off the dust. Don't let a past disappointment constrain you. Don't allow yesterday's failures or burdens to keep you from the joy of today's witness, whatever form it might take.

Necesitamos echar un buen vistazo al equipaje inútil y poco constructivo de nuestro pasado que estamos rastreando en nuestros encuentros presentes y futuros.

¿Cuál es la “ciudad” que Dios te pide que visites hoy en Su nombre? ¿Es una conversación difícil con un amigo, un breve testimonio a un extraño en la fila de la caja, una llamada para estar presente con alguien de tu familia? Antes de irte, recuerda, sacúdete el polvo. No dejes que una decepción pasada te limite. No permitas que los fracasos o las cargas de ayer te alejen del gozo del testimonio de hoy, cualquiera que sea la forma que adoptes.
