



Florida Amendment 4- Vote NO!

By Archbishop Thomas Wenski - The Archdiocese of Miami Florida Amendment 4, which will appear on Florida's November 2024 ballot, is an extreme proposal that legalizes full term abortion with no protections for the preborn child, including when the child is capable of feeling pain. This proposed amendment to our state constitution would prohibit all restrictions on abortion before viability and create a broad exception that any "healthcare provider" could exploit to allow abortion up to birth. I urge all Catholics and people of good will: **Vote "NO" on Amendment 4!**

I am often at parishes throughout the archdiocese administering the Sacrament of Confirmation. This is true especially in the weeks before and after Easter. The gifts of the Holy Spirit, first bestowed on the Apostles on Pentecost Sunday, are given to the baptized to better equip us to be witnesses to Christ, crucified but now risen from the dead. As confirmed Catholics we are to witness in an increasingly secularized world that God matters and because God matters, human beings, created in God's own image and likeness, including the unborn, matter as well. What Pope Benedict XVI had characterized as the "dictatorship of relativism" and Pope Francis has described as "ideological colonialism" wishes to reduce faith to the realm of the "private" and the "subjective" and thus tries to exclude religious voices from the public square. In spite of such gale force "headwinds," Catholics are nevertheless to engage themselves in the public square and do so coherently and unapologetically. To bear witness is our duty as faithful Catholics – and it is our right as faith filled citizens. Vote "NO" on Amendment 4! This is not to "impose our views" but to "make our proposal" about what is necessary for human flourishing in society. By insisting that every human being matters, we bring to public policy debates on issues of human dignity, justice and peace, an understanding of the human person that, while founded on the Christian Scriptures, is also accessible to human reason. In making our proposal, we hope to persuade our fellow Floridians to vote "NO" on Amendment 4!

Food That Perishes

It's so easy to do the right thing because we want to tick all the right boxes. We want to live by the law. We want to accomplish the work of God. Or, at least, we say that we do. But Jesus tells us that in order to accomplish the work of God, we have to believe in the one he sent. And to believe in Christ is to be filled with the spirit of truth - to do what is right because it is right, not because we want to be filled with good feelings. What is the difference between doing what is right because you want to be a good Christian, and doing what is right because you believe in Christ? It's the difference between eating manna and the Eucharist. One fills your stomach and keeps you alive, and nothing more. The other satisfies a hunger you might not have even known you had, or if you did know, you called it by another name — sadness, unfulfillment, fear. One achieves a corporeal goal, and that's the end of it. The other accomplishes something invisibly, secretly, silently, and though there is physical evidence of its work all around us, you have to be shrewd to recognize it. It's the difference between making a social media post condemning sin and enveloping a sinner (the one at our dinner table, the one on the street, the one staring back at us in the mirror) with love and concern. It's the difference between simply going to Mass and living the Gospel. It's the difference between speaking to God and saying a prayer. It's the difference between telling someone they're wrong and telling them about the truth. There's nothing wrong doing what is right because we long for heaven, and there's nothing wrong with eating manna if you're starving. But that alone isn't enough. We must also long for the bread of heaven, the bread that gives life to the world.

Es la diferencia entre hacer una publicación en las redes sociales condenando el pecado y envolver a un pecador (el que está en nuestra mesa, el que está en la calle, el que nos mira en el espejo) con amor y preocupación. Es la diferencia entre simplemente ir a Misa y vivir el Evangelio. Es la diferencia entre hablar con Dios y decir una oración. Es la diferencia entre decirle a alguien que está equivocado y contarle la verdad. No hay nada malo en hacer lo correcto porque anhelamos el cielo, y no hay nada malo en comer maná si te mueres de hambre. Pero eso por sí solo no es suficiente. También debemos añorar el pan del cielo, el pan que da vida al mundo.
