Men: after shave, disposable razor/shaving gel, handkerchief, socks

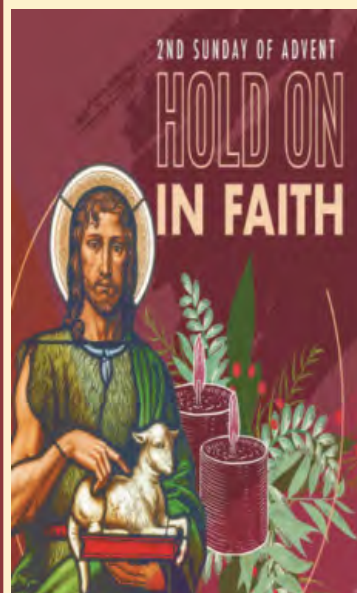

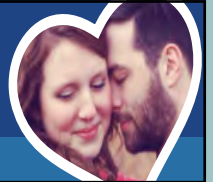
